#### For Voters Who Are Voting In Person

# Are you voting in person in this election? Here are some things you should keep in mind to help you lower your risk of getting COVID-19.

As a voter, you can minimize the risk of COVID-19 transmission at polling locations by using personal prevention practices. This includes wearing a mask and maintaining at least six feet of distance from people who don't live with you.

You can also:

- Follow preventive measures for transportation to and from the polls.
- Check voting locations and requirements before going to vote because these may have changed due to COVID-19.
- Try to avoid crowds.
  - Use early voting, if available.
  - Vote at off-peak times, such as mid-morning.
- Bring an alcohol-based hand sanitizer containing at least 60% alcohol to use before and after voting.
- Check the <u>local election office</u> for information on voting options available in the jurisdiction.
- Ask poll workers what options they offer for casting your ballot if you have symptoms of COVID-19.

#### Notification

Remember, as part of our Northline Notification Protocol:

- These are the reasons to contact Ricardo Aguilar (<u>raguilar@northlinellc.com</u>), Emergency Operations Team Liaison Officer:
  - I went home with COVID-19 symptoms
  - I stayed home sick with COVID-19 symptoms
  - I was advised by a Health Care Provider to be tested
  - I was made aware of someone else that has COVID-19 symptoms or stayed home
  - I was asked to leave the jobsite by the customer due to a potential exposure
  - I tested positive for COVID-19
  - I encountered someone known to have tested positive for COVID-19, or
  - I completed a trip to a CDC-categorized Coronavirus Warning Level 3 location
